It begins *in relationship* and continues throughout the member's lifetime.


It is the responsibility of each member, their mission organization, their supporting church(es), their leadership (on and off the field), their colleagues, their families, their individual supporters, and their member care providers.

Programs:

- **1. Classic ReBoot** (ON): A highly relational and energetic co-ed transition retreat for Missionary Kids (MKs) ages 17 20, at Tyndale University, Toronto, August 12-19.
- **2. Wilderness ReBoot** (AB): An off-the-grid, highly relational, co-ed retreat for MKs ages 21-35, in the Kananaskis mountains, July 1-7. Challenging both spiritually and physically.
- **3. RE-VIEW West** (AB): Providing an opportunity for CCWs in transition (singles, couples and families) to participate in spiritual and ministry reflection in a debriefing retreat outside of Calgary, November 19-24.

Team Building:

- **4. Mobilizing Prayer:** Strengthening our foundations by interactively praising and praying together: daily, monthly,... "without ceasing"!
- **5.** Developing strategic partnerships: Developing and growing MORE is done by serving others, through cooperation and collaboration, extending mercy and generosity, through loving acts of service.
- **6. Raising Support:** As a group of talented, highly motivated personnel who deeply value the work of Member Care, we are completely dependent on God to provide through the gifts of others.

Personnel (MORE Staff & Associates):

- **7. Personal Development Training:** Equipping and strengthening MORE Network personnel through a 5-year program, raising self -and others- awareness, improving skills and abilities in key areas for service.
- **8. MORE Advisory Council:** Seeking God's wisdom, we will form an Advisory Council with the leaders of member care organizations, supporters and clear minded thinkers, to regularly meet, evaluate and influence the future of the MORE Network.
- **9. Peer Debriefing:** Will be launched to encourage, support, care for, and help peers within the MORE Network through one-on-one regular meaningful meetings, in absolute confidentiality.
- **10. Raising up leadership:** Finding an individual or couple to join Mike & Diane Fietje as co-Directors of the MORE Network, with gifts and talents complementary to each other, to share the weight of the ministry.

MK Resourcing:

- 11. Shepherds Council & Global Third Culture Hub: Sharing with New Sending Country leaders what we have enjoyed in Canada for years ... access to recommended & vetted resources, structured transition retreats for Third Culture Kids (TCKs), and care and support for families.
- **12. MORE MK Education Network:** Available to cross-cultural parents and Member Care personnel, a well-informed perspective on how to educate each child while on assignment and after, through the collaborative wisdom of expertise of personnel from Canada and worldwide.
- **13. Adult TCK Research:** Seeking to deepen our understanding of the long-term impact on the development of Canadian passport holding children, spiritually and relationally, from living cross-culturally.
- **14. MK Mentoring Ministry:** Offering insightful, wise, relationship mentoring for MKs repatriating to Canada, supporting them through the acculturation process, and their spiritual and physical development at a crucial stage in their lives.
- **15. MK Gatherings:** A highly relational time for MK peers, developing friendships, going deeper spiritually, and encouraging one another while enjoying great food and activities.

CCW Resourcing:

- **16. Debriefing 101:** An interactive, experiential, and skill-building workshop providing the "why" and "how" of debriefing CCWs repatriating from a cross-cultural assignment, and/or preparing to re-mobilize.
- **17. Alongsiders:** A personalized, loving visit for CCWs on assignment by discreet, caring, supportive couples who have both the necessary experience and the training to come alongside those who are constantly giving of themselves.
- 18. MORE Network Resource Library: A multi-faceted library of resources containing: online access to a vetted, curated multi-media catalog, pertinent to CCWs and Member Care (MC) personnel; member access to vetted, Christian mental health professionals throughout Canada with cross-cultural experience; access to recommended Canadian retreat centres; access to MC training; access for CCWs to top tier financial personnel for counsel and advice; and (soon to come) access to vehicles during ministry assignments.
- **19. Strengthen MORE Relationships:** Everything we do is based on relationships. Relationships are shared, and deeply valued as Jesus taught. Therefore, we live "*Ministry at the speed of relationships*", through personal visits, mentoring, encouraging, prayer, and spiritual development. No strings attached.
